

## NMCA quarterly bulletin: September 2025

Autumn has well and truly arrived with its storms and strong winds, downpours heavy enough to

turn the <u>waterfall</u> into a deafening torrent but enough calm days and sunshine to show up the changing colours of hill slopes and woodlands. It's been a bumper year for fruit, from summer bilberries, blackberries and wild crab apples to acorns and hazelnuts, rich pickings for wildlife and fruit-picking walkers alike.



It's been a bumper year for Nantmor too! After months of planning, major plumbing works finally got under way in late June leading to an almost complete overhaul of the water system. Starting at the dam, we now have a new intake pipe leading to the house, with new collection tanks, new storage tanks in the loft and another on the landing to boost hot water, which is now supplied to the showers by a pumped system. Cold water and hot taps are still gravity fed, but the

power of the showers is now, according to our visitors, 'fantastic'! The work was urgent and needed to be completed during the dry season, before the inevitable surge in water from autumn storms.
